\*Two separate permits are required whenever a new septic system is installed (New Construction) or an existing septic system is replaced or altered (Alteration):

1. The **Test Hole & Plan Review Permit** is required to have Oakland's Registered Environmental Health Specialist witness the test holes and review the engineer's design plans. This permit fee is generally paid for by the homeowner or the individual who hires the engineer. Sometimes, the engineer pays for this permit and, in turn, bills his/her client.
2. The **Construction Permit** is issued only to Oakland Licensed Septic Contractor after the septic engineering plans for the project have been reviewed and approved by Oakland's Registered Environmental Health Specialist.

\*\*The Alternative Treatment System fee is collected when the Construction Permit is issued. This fee is to cover the additional work required to monitor these systems.

\*\*\*All septic repairs require a permit and may only be done by an Oakland Licensed Septic Contractor.
