#### GOALS FOR NEXT YEAR

The discussion of goals for next year continued. It was determined that in addition to the general goals continually held by the board, it may also be beneficial to provide educational programs on various topics including the dangers of vaping; the importance of, and different types of, vaccines; tick-borne diseases; and wildlife awareness and safety.

## NEW BUSINESS

#### **BODY ART**

The process for any application for a license involving a body art procedure that breaks skin (such as microblading and tattooing) was discussed. The property that the application concerns must be zoned for that type of business. The applicant may need to add one or more sinks to the establishment, thereby including the

likelihood that a larger septic would be required. Compliance with all body art code would be mandatory. The facility would also require yearly inspection and licensing by the Board of Health's Health Inspector, which would require a yearly licensing fee, as well. The possibility of creating an ordinance to set the yearly licensing fee was discussed and remains a possibility for a future meeting.
