

November 11, 2013 – Oakland Flood Commission Meeting

The meeting started at 7:35 p.m. Mayor Schwager said that she attends all of our meetings, so she will be our liaison.

Lew Levy announced that there is a meeting on scheduled for tomorrow, November 12<sup>th</sup> with the Millennium group regarding applying for a \$100,000. Grant money.

We need to get the PPI/CRS meeting set and would like those involved to check about the week of December 1<sup>st</sup> before setting an actual date.

Roy Bauberger said that the NO WAKE signs were ordered. We need to have a rule in place. It comes under Parks Rules and Regulations and we do have a speed limit of 2 ½ miles per hour. He said that he has been working with Trout Unlimited and they have inspected the river since the water is at a very low level at this time. The engineering is in place. He has used GPS and has pictures and documentation of the 7 areas. All of this has been submitted to County for the Mitigation Plan. Trout Unlimited also inspected the Potash Lake area and the original project area. A river cleanup also encompassed the Potash Lake area and as usual Dave Potash was a very big help and supplied equipment. While doing the inspection with Trout Unlimited and quite by chance they met the County Blue Acres people who were doing an inspection of the Roosevelt area for the buy out of properties. The bridge that Potash has is still available but we would need to get DEP approval and engineering.

Gina Steele is still working on the web site. The town is getting a new web site and a link will go from that site to the Flood Commission site.
