RESOLUTION 05-01 AWARD BID-RECREATION CENTER WALKING PATH On motion of Councilwoman Coira, seconded by Councilman Jensen, the following resolution be introduced, adopted and duly passed by roll call vote:

WHEREAS, on December 3, 2014, the Borough of Oakland received thirteen (13) bids for the Recreation Center Walking Path Project; and

WHEREAS, Diamond Construction, had the lowest responsible bid with a base bid price of \$112,735.00;

WHEREAS, the Borough Engineer and the Borough Attorney have reviewed the bids and have recommended acceptance of the bid from Diamond Construction, 35 Beaverson Blvd., Suite 12C, Brick, New Jersey 08723; and

WHEREAS, the Chief Financial Officer has certified funds are available in Account # G-02-14-001-000 in the amount of \$28,619.00, T-13-56-286-020 in the amount of \$32,000.00 and T-13-56-286-020 in the amount of \$52,116.00.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the bid of Diamond Construction in the total amount of \$112,735.00 is hereby accepted; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Borough Administrator is directed to prepare an appropriate contract for the same; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Mayor and Borough Clerk are directed to execute the agreement of behalf of the Borough.

RESOLUTION 15-02 AUTHORIZE HIRING OF CHIEF FINANCIAL OFFICER On motion of Councilman Jensen, seconded by Councilman Kulmala, the following resolution be introduced, adopted and duly passed by roll call vote:

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Oakland desire to retain the services of a full-time Chief Financial Officer; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Oakland have considered candidates and wish to retain the services of Donna Mollineaux as CFO/Treasurer of the Borough of Oakland; and

WHEREAS, the Borough and Ms. Mollineaux have agreed on salary and services to be provided;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Oakland that Donna Mollineaux is hereby appointed as full-time CFO of the Borough of Oakland at an initial annual salary of \$117,000, said appointment to be effective for a term commencing Monday, January 19, 2015, and running through December 31, 2018.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that pursuant to Borough Code section 2-3.5A(c), Ms. Mollineaux is hereby appointed as Treasurer for a term commencing January 19, 2015, and running until the 2016 Reorganization meeting.

## **RESOLUTION 15-03 HIRE FULL-TIME CLERK TYPIST**

WHEREAS, In 2011 the Borough established the position of part-time Recreation Aide to provide administrative and operational support to the Recreation Commission; and

WHEREAS, a vacancy now exists in that position; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Christina Clipperton was hired as a part-time Clerk in 2014 to provide administrative support to the Planning and Zoning Boards; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Clipperton has shown the ability and desire to learn all aspects of her job as well as other aspects of the Borough's operations.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED; that Christina Clipperton be appointed as a full-time Clerk at an annual salary of \$36,400.00, effective January 12, 2015, to fill the vacant position supporting the Recreation Commission and to continue as Planning and Zoning Board Secretary.
