RESOLUTION 20-199 AUTHORIZE CONNECTION FEE TO NBCUA TO DECOMMISSION SEWERAGE TREATMENT PLANTS

On motion of Councilman Pignatelli, seconded by Councilman Levy, the following resolution be introduced, adopted and duly passed by roll call vote:

WHEREAS, the Borough of Oakland owns and operates three sewerage treatment plants and their related sewerage collection system which serves selected areas within the Borough of Oakland; and

WHEREAS, there are certain violations with respect to the operations of the sewerage treatment plants; and

WHEREAS, the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection and the Borough have agreed to a schedule for the Borough to decommission the three sewerage treatment plants and construct a system for the conveyance of sewerage from the Borough's three sewerage treatment plants to the Northwest Bergen County Utilities Authority treatment plant; and

WHEREAS, the Borough has committed substantial funds in order to develop a wastewater management plan and to design sanitary sewer improvements; and

WHEREAS, the Borough adopted Resolution #18-355 authorizing a contract to Boswell Engineering in an amount not to exceed \$260,000 to provide for engineering services for Phase I of the sanitary sewer improvements to include decommissioning of the three sewerage treatment plants; and

WHEREAS, the Borough adopted Resolution #20-176 approving an Administrative Consent Order with the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection for the decommissioning of the three sewerage treatment plants; and

WHEREAS, the Borough adopted Resolution #20-183 authorizing the treatment works application for the decommissioning of its sewerage treatment plants and constructing a conveyance system to the Northwest Bergen County Utilities Authority; and

WHEREAS, the treatment works application was submitted to the Northwest Bergen County Utilities Authority; and

WHEREAS, the Northwest Bergen County Utilities Authority, by Resolution #70-2020 adopted July 21, 2020, authorized the execution of the application, conditioned on a written commitment of the Borough reflecting payment by the Borough of a connection fee in the amount of \$802,417.56; and

WHEREAS, the Borough has been committed to the decommissioning of these three sewerage treatment plants and is committed to fund any and all costs necessary for the decommissioning of the plants, including the connection fee as required by the Authority;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Oakland as follows:

- 1. The Borough of Oakland is hereby committed to pay a connection fee to the Northwest Bergen County Utilities Authority in the amount of \$802,417.56 as set forth in the Resolution of the Authority dated July 21, 2020.
- 2. The Borough of Oakland will negotiate a mutually acceptable timetable for the payment of this fee with Northwest Bergen County Utilities Authority;
- 3. This Resolution is intended to demonstrate the commitment of the Borough of Oakland to pay the necessary fees and charges to the Northwest Bergen County Utilities Authority, including but not limited to the connection fee.

Councilman Levy explained that this resolution is just saying that the Borough is going to work with the NWBCUA for the connection fee to decommission our sewerage treatment plants.
