

Oakland Environmental Commission Meeting
April 2009

The April 14, 2009 meeting of the Oakland Environmental Commission opened at 7:45 PM. Members present were Lee Haymon, chairman, Erich Kamm, Mike Lynch, and Mark Ostapczuk.

Due to the low attendance, the topics discussed were limited.

1. Green Team – Lee Haymon had a list of possible groups and individuals to be considered by the Mayor and Council. A team of 16 members with 2 alternates was suggested and discussed. Business, School, Faith, Borough officials, volunteer groups, and non-affiliated individuals are all resource groups that should be considered.

2. Earth Day and other town events –
 - a. April 25th Saturday, 9AM at Potash (Schuyler) Lake the Environmental Commission is planning a River Walk clean-up.

 - b. May 17th Sunday a river clean-up inspired by Oakland's Emergency Management organization. The Environmental Commission is welcomed. The Fire Department, First Aid Squad, and local Boy Scout Troops will possibly be involved.

 - c. The Town Carnival will be held July 23, 24, 25 at the Recreation fields. Town organizations are welcome to have tables at the Fair. It was suggested that the Shade Tree Commission, Environmental Commission, and Health Department could cover one table on various days.

3. Planning Board – Board of Adjustments –
 - a. Fanale Property 127 McCoy Rd is on the agenda for April 14th, 2009.
