

**OAKLAND RECREATION COMMISSION
MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING
TUESDAY, MARCH 30, 2015**

The regular monthly meeting of the Oakland Recreation Commission was called to order at 8:00 p.m. by Chairman Guadagnino, with the Flag Salute, at the Danny D'Elia Recreation Center under the public sunshine laws. Commissioners Logatto, Scalabrini, Malmud, Haas and Saliani were present. Rec Secretary, Chrissy and Councilwoman Sandra Coira were also present.

The Commission recognized a moment of silence in remembrance of Mrs. D'Elia who passed away over the weekend.

Motion to excuse Comm. Perneti and Comm. King from the meeting was made by Comm. Logatto, seconded by Comm. Malmud and passed.

The meeting was opened to the public upon motion made by Comm. Malmud seconded by Comm. Logatto and passed.

BASEBALL – Comm. Saliani – The last draft has been finalized. Numbers are down in rec. Minors we have 6 teams, majors we have 4 teams. We are going to try and change the rec experience to improve the program. Travel tryouts will be at NJ Sports House.

BASKETBALL – Comm. Scalabrini – Season ended last Monday night. Ball collection will begin shortly. Working on changing some rec practices/games to get the kids more playing time. Travel program – 5th grade boys won the championship. Surveys have gone out and still waiting for responses.

FOOTBALL – Comm. Perneti – No report.

GOLF – Chairman Haas – Flyers have been approved.

ROLLER HOCKEY – Comm. Haas – Season is complete. We had a problem at the last senior game involving players, parents & coaches. The league has been notified. The two players involved have been suspended for 10 games next season.

SOCCER – Comm. Saliani – Registration date is out. The flyer needs to be approved. There will be two sign up dates and mail in registration. We are going to bring in some trainers for the younger level to develop some different programs. The 5th & 6th grade is trying to put an all-star team together to play surrounding towns in a tournament.

SOFTBALL – Comm. Logatto – Drafts are done for the three divisions. Everyone is ready to go. All equipment is in and uniforms are on schedule. Travel tryouts have begun and will be complete by the end of next week.

CAPITAL PROJECTS

Complex Lights – The digging is complete. They have to run the lines and should be ready for the lights in approximately 2 weeks. They will fix field 2 & 9 sprinklers which they broke. Fields 2, 3 & 8 still have a lot of frost and the fields haven't been fixed yet. They should be ready to go by next week.

Walking path – They are going to start it next week. They will allow us to use the fields however if anyone goes into the construction site then they will close the entire rec complex. No one will be allowed beyond the orange fencing. Should only take 2 weeks to complete

Roller Rink scoreboard – Will happen late May or early June.

Lightening detector – Is up and the modem needs to be turned on. Instructions/policy will be put up on the website.
