

**OAKLAND RECREATION COMMISSION
MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING
MONDAY MAY 19, 2014**

The regular monthly meeting of the Oakland Recreation Commission was called to order at 8:00 p.m. by Chairman Guadagnino, with the Flag Salute, at the Danny D'Elia Recreation Center under the public sunshine laws. CAPITAL PROJECTS

Field 2 Scoreboard –Vendor has received the purchase order and is in the process of designing the scoreboard. Hopefully we will have the design done this week. DPW and Father’s Club are working diligently to get the scoreboard up.

Lightning Detection System – Being sent out to bid.

Walking Path – Meeting with Boswell, the will be getting ready to go out to bid. October 15th is the date we are hoping to get started.

Football PA system – We have speakers already up on field 8. Going to try to use existing wiring however we will need to replace speakers.

Parking lot re-design – Chairman Guadagnino and Vice Chair Logatto met with Mike Kozak and Mr. Panzenhagen who came up with a plan for the parking lot re-design. They should be able to rework the parking area quickly to increase the lot by at least 15 spots. Chairman Guadagnino was to have a meeting with Boswell engineering, Rich Kunze, Fire and Police to discuss the plan.
