Ms. Caperino briefly went over Educational Programs being offered by Bergen County for environmental cleaup.

Councilman Pignatelli gave an update on the progress of the Chicken Ordinance. He stated that the ordinance had not been adopted at the meeting because there was disagreement with number four — a resident did not agree that there should be a run if the back yard was fenced in, so it was changed to say that if a run was provided, there would be at least 5 ft. allotted per chicken. Ms. Caperino asked how the back yard cleanliness would then be addressed if chickens were defacating all over the back yard. He responded that they must maintain the yard and the waste would be removed at least weekly and properly disposed of.

Councilman Pignatelli raised concerns about marijuana rules and regulations not having been passed yet in regard to cultivation, manufacture and sale. He mentioned that if there were not a ban on this in town at present, then in the future, the Borough would have to accept whatever rules and regulations are passed in regard to marijuana by the State. He asked the Board of Health members to send their comments to the Assistant to the Administrator, Michael Carelli. Mr. Romans asked if the Board would like to have a position regarding banning marijuana. Councilman Pignatelli added that each member as a resident has the right to comment and then they could also comment as The Board of Health together. Mr. Tiffinger stated that he would work with Ms. Steele to draft a statement for the Board to review.
