- 2. **Band Shell**: The Committee is planning on consulting an acoustics engineer to help with the installation of the band shell.
- 3. **Bird and Bat Houses**: Mike met with Carol Peterson regarding the installation of the bird and bat houses. Carol is researching how it should be done properly and she will report back to the Committee.
- 4. **Stream**: The Committee hopes to work in conjunction with the Environmental Commission to coordinate a cleanup of the stream. Carol Peterson also applied for a grant to plant trees along the stream.

Erich Kamm: is concerned with the runoff from the great lawn into the C1 stream. Lee Haymon stated that the location will be engineered so there will be a buffer zone of vegetation before the water reaches the stream.
