

MINUTES OF THE PARK COMMITTEE

July 9, 2019

1. The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. The members present were Mike Guadagnino, Steve Saliani, Lee Haymon, Nancy Larkin, Sandra Coira and Councilman Robert Knapp, liaison. Peter Kikot absent, absence unanimously approved.
2. Open to the Public: no one present.
3. Salute to the Flag and the Pledge of Allegiance.
4. Mike read the meeting announcement:

This meeting is being held in accordance with the Open Public Meetings Act, duly announced, advertised and posted in the municipal building.

5. Work Session

1. **Great lawn and Band shell:** the great lawn has been planted. Some butterfly plants were moved prior to the first mowing. Work is continuing with the band shell.
 2. **Dog Park:** The Dog Park Committee is trying to decide what is the best way to bring in the boulders. The unknown factor they believe is whether the bridge will be able to hold the weight of the truck that needs to be used. The dog park committee needs to raise approximately \$30 K to \$35 K more to reach their goal. They are looking at running a super 50/50 raffle and a pocket bingo to meet their goal.
 3. **Parking Lot:** it was reported that the parking lot plans are still being worked on and the usage of pervious material is still being investigated.
 4. **New Bridge:** the bridge needs to be moved possibly near the stream. Boswell will be contacted in order to possibly get permission from DEP.
