

MINUTES OF THE PARK COMMITTEE

October 27, 2020

1. The meeting was called to order at 8:00 p.m. The members present were Chairman Mike Guadagnino, Lee Haymon, Nancy Larkin, Steve Saliani, Peter Kikot, Sandra Coira and Councilman Robert Knapp, liaison.
2. Salute to the Flag and the Pledge of Allegiance.
3. Mike read the meeting announcement: *This meeting is being held in accordance with the Open Public Meetings Act, duly announced, advertised and posted in the municipal building.*

Minutes of the previous meeting were reviewed and approved.

4. Work Session

1. **Parking Lot:** Chairman Guadagnino reported that the parking lot area has already been milled and it is expected to be completed next week.
2. **Band Shell:** Chairman Guadagnino reported that he had met with the Borough engineer regarding the work that still needs to be completed relating to the band shell. Peter Kikot reported that he will try to meet with the Borough engineer as well in the near future to help complete the work.
3. **Bench and trees:** Peter Kikot reported that he anticipates being able to work on this project soon but that he will need some help with the GPS mapping aspect of it. Lee Haymon stated that he will be able to help Peter with the GPS mapping starting around mid-November.
4. **Dog Park:** Ryan Schwertfeger reported that most of the tree work in and around the Dog Park area has been completed and that there approximately 5

or 6 trees left. He also reported that the excavation work has mostly been completed but that there are still some boulders left that need to be moved. Ryan anticipates that by late-February to early-March the work will be completed and that he hopes the Dog Park will be able to open to the public around mid-May of 2021.

5. **Bike Path:** Work is continuing on this project and a meeting will be scheduled with the Borough engineer and Steve Wagner to continue the project's progress.
6. **Park Cleanup:** The Park Committee is hoping to coordinate a cleanup effort in collaboration with the Environmental Commission, as has been done in the past. Lee Hayman reported that he was unable to attend the prior Environmental Commission meeting but that he will work with them to coordinate a cleanup soon.
