

MINUTES OF THE PARK COMMITTEE

September 17, 2019

1. The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. The members present were Mike Guadagnino, Steve Saliani, Nancy Larkin and Sandra Coira. Peter Kikot, Lee Haymon, Councilman Robert Knapp, absences unanimously approved.
2. Open to the Public: no one present.
3. Salute to the Flag and the Pledge of Allegiance.
4. Mike read the meeting announcement:

This meeting is being held in accordance with the Open Public Meetings Act, duly announced, advertised and posted in the municipal building.

5. Work Session

1. **Swords to Plows:** It was reported that Peter Marcalus, who has taken the lead on this project, has raised a substantial amount of money.
 2. **Dog Park:** the big boulders will be moved. Boris landscaping and the Borough engineer met and they will be moving the rocks. The Dog Park is continuing their efforts to raise funds. They reported that they need about \$35,000 more in either cash donations or pledged services in order to meet their total fundraising goal.
 3. **Parking Lot:** it was reported that the Borough has decided to use Macadam instead of the alternatives which were also brought forward to the Borough.
 4. **Great Lawn, band shell, benches and band shell:** a few benches will likely be installed around the great lawn area and additional shade trees will be planted. The band shell and the parking lot should be completed this winter.
