Upon receipt of a Mailbox Damage Claim, the Superintendent of Public Works or designee shall investigate the alleged claim to determine if the damage was caused by the plow blade, vehicle itself and/or thrown snow comingoff the plow. Upon a determination that the damage was caused by the

plow blade, vehicle and/or thrown snow coming off the plow, the homeowner may be reimbursed in an amount not to exceed \$100 upon submission of an itemized receipt for the cost of the new mailbox and/or post. Note that your mailbox <u>must</u> be installed in accordance with the United States Postal Service guidelines in order for your claim to be approved.

Disclaimer: The Borough of Oakland is not admitting to any liability for the damages sustained to your mailbox during snow removal based upon the review or payment of your claim. Upon receipt of your claim, the Department of Public Works will investigate the issue and you will be notified of the approval or denial of your claim. Your claim must be submitted within 90 days of the loss. Failure to submit your claim in a timely mannerwill result in the denial of your claim.
