ORDINANCE NO. 17-CODE-758**

**ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER II, SECTION 2-5  
OF THE OAKLAND CODE, ENTITLED "POLICE DEPARTMENT,"  
SO AS TO AMEND THE TABLE OF ORGANIZATION**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF OAKLAND AS FOLLOWS:

**Section I.**

Chapter 2-5.1(a), of the Oakland Code, entitled "Police Department-Creation of Department and Committee," be and the same is hereby amended so that the table of organization shall hereinafter read as follows:

2-5.1 Creation of Department and Committee

a. A police department is hereby established for the Borough. The officers of the Police Department shall consist of the following positions:

1. a chief;
2. one (1) captain;
3. two (2) lieutenants;
4. six (6) sergeants;
5. twenty-one (21) patrolmen.

**Section II.** All other parts, portions and provisions of Chapter 2-5 of the Oakland Code be and the same are hereby ratified and confirmed, except where inconsistent with the terms hereof. In the event of any such inconsistency, the terms of this ordinance shall be deemed to govern.

**Section III.** The terms of this Ordinance are hereby declared to be severable; should any part, portion or provision hereof be declared invalid or unconstitutional, said finding shall not affect any other part, portion or provision thereof.

**Section IV.** This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final passage and publication according to law.
