BOROUGH OF OAKLAND BERGEN COUNTY, NEW JERSEY ORDINANCE NO.17-CODE-763

AN ORDINANCE REVISING, AMENDING AND REENACTING PARAGRAPHS 1 THROUGH 16 OF ORDINANCE NO-17-CODE-759 TITLED "THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF OAKLAND, COUNTY OF BERGEN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, ENTITLED "SALARIES OF MUNICIPAL EMPLOYEES"

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council are desirous of amending Paragraph 8, Police Department;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Oakland as follows:

SECTION I. Paragraph 8 of Ordinance 17-Code-759 respecting Police Department is hereby amended such that the same shall hereinafter read as follows:

In addition to the police ranges herein established, those officers assigned as detectives shall receive an additional compensation pursuant to the terms of the PBA contract while so assigned. This is to be considered additional base pay for pension, longevity and overtime purposes.

Police officers shall also receive compensation for court time and college credits as prescribed in the contract between the Borough and their bargaining group.

SECTION II. All other parts, portions, and provisions of Ordinance No. 17-Code-759 are hereby ratified and confirmed, except where inconsistent with the terms hereof. In the event of any such inconsistencies, the terms of this Ordinance whall be deemed to govern.

SECTION III. Any part, portion or provision of this Ordinance deemed unconstitutional or invalid, shall not affect any other parts, portions and provisions hereof. The terms of this Ordinance are deemed to be severable.
