

**BOROUGH OF OAKLAND
ORDINANCE NO. 21-CODE-834**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING
THE REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE
BOROUGH OF OAKLAND TO ESTABLISH A PROTOCOL
FOR HONORING DECEASED OAKLAND ELECTED
OFFICIALS**

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Oakland wish to establish a protocol for honoring deceased elected officials who have served the Borough of Oakland.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Oakland, Bergen County, New Jersey as follows:

Section 1.

The Mayor and Council, upon timely notification and verification of a death of an elected official who has served the Borough of Oakland, shall adopt a resolution designating a remembrance day for the deceased elected official. On the remembrance day, the flag of the United States shall be flown at half-staff at the Municipal Building. The flag shall be flown upon an existing flag staff. The resolution and the flag shall be presented to the family of the deceased official in a suitable presentation box. The flag shall be made in the United States.

Section 2. Should any part, portion or provision of this ordinance be held unconstitutional or invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of this ordinance as a whole, or any other part thereof.

Section 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon publication and final passage according to law.
