Authorize Vehicle Auction

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of NJSA 40A:11-36, the Borough of Oakland may sell any personal property; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Oakland have determined that the property listed in this resolution is no longer needed for public use and wishes to divest said property,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Oakland as follows:

- 1. The sale of the surplus property shall be conducted online using Municibid (www.municibid.com) pursuant to New Jersey Local Finance Notice 2008-9. Terms of the agreement are available on the vendor's website and available in the Borough Clerk's Office.
- 2. The surplus property to be sold is as follows:

- 3. The surplus property as identified shall be sold in 'as is' condition without express or implied warranties.
- 4. In accordance with NJSA 39:10-9.1, the certificates of ownership for former police vehicles shall state that the motor vehicles were used as police patrol vehicles and notice is provided that the buyer shall continue to so state on each subsequent sale or transfer
- 5. The successful bidder will be required to pay in cash or certified check made out to the Borough of Oakland at the time of pick up of the vehicle. The Borough will not deliver the vehicle to the successful bidder.

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6. The vehicle is to be transferred and taken off the site within 10 business days after approval of the sale by the Governing Body.
