Authorize Engineer for Iroquois Pumping Station Additional Work

WHEREAS, there is a need for additional work associated with the Iroquois Pumping Station Upgrades; and

WHEREAS, Boswell Engineering has submitted a proposal dated July 8, 2021 for the engineering services required at a total not to exceed cost of \$ 30,000 broken down as follows;

Task 1 Field Investigation	\$ 2,500
Task 2 Design	\$ 27,500

WHEREAS, the Chief Financial Officer has certified funds are available in Account #C-06-56-833-201;

WHEREAS, Boswell Engineering has complied with the Borough of Oakland's Pay to Play requirements as outlined in Ordinance 12-CODE-669 adopted on July 11, 2012; and

WHEREAS, the award of the contract is for a professional service for which no public bidding is required;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mayor and Council hereby authorize Boswell Engineering to perform the engineering services for the additional work for the Iroquois Pumping Station Upgrades project at a cost not to exceed \$ 30,000.00; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Mayor and Borough Clerk are hereby authorized to execute the agreement on behalf of the Borough.
