RESOLUTION REQUESTING PERMISSION FOR THE DEDICATION BY RIDER FOR
POLICE HONOR GUARD UNIFORM DEDICATED DONATIONS AS REQUIRED BY
N.J.S.A. 40A:5-29

WHEREAS, permission is required of the Director of the Division of Local Government Services for approval as a dedication by rider of revenues received by a municipality when the revenue is not subject to reasonable accurate estimates in advance, and

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A:5-29 provides for receipt of funds from gifts, bequests, and donations by the municipality to provide for the operating costs to administer this act; and

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A:4-39 provides the dedicated revenues anticipated from the Boroughs Police Honor Guard Uniform Donations are hereby anticipated as revenue and are hereby appropriated for the purpose to which said revenue is dedicated by statute or other legal requirements,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Oakland, County of Bergen, State of New Jersey as follows:

1. The Mayor and Council hereby request permission of the Director of the Division of Local Government Services to place funds received for the Boroughs Police Honor Guard Uniforms in a specified fund to be considered a dedication by rider to the budget in accordance with N.J.S.A. 40A:4-39 for Police Honor Guard Uniforms.
2. The Municipal Clerk of the Borough of Oakland is hereby directed to forward two certified copies of this resolution to the Director of the Division of Local Government Services.
