WHEREAS, as of January 1, 2006, N.J.S.A. 19:44A-20.1 et seq., commonly known as the "State Pay to Play" law, enacted by the New Jersey State Legislature became effective; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 19:44A-20.1 et seq., a municipality may not award contracts with a value in excess of \$17,500.00 to a business entity which has made reportable contributions in excess of \$200.00, in the aggregate, to any candidate's committee of any person serving in an elective public office of the said municipality when such contract was awarded, unless said business entity is awarded a contract under a "fair and open process" pursuant to N.J.S.A. 19:44A-20.1 et seq.; and

WHEREAS, a "fair and open process" constitutes the following: (1) public advertisement of a Request for Qualifications (hereinafter the "RFQ") with ten (10) calendar days' notice prior to the receipt of responses to the RFQ; (2) award of contract under a process that provides for public solicitation of qualifications; (3) award of contract under publicly disclosed criteria established, in writing, by the municipality prior to the solicitation of qualifications; and (4) the municipality shall publicly open and announce the qualifications when awarded; and

WHEREAS, it has become necessary for the Borough of Oakland (hereinafter the "Borough") to engage legal, financial and engineering professionals and the Borough desires to appoint such professionals for 2024 by a "fair and open process" pursuant to N.J.S.A. 19:44A-20.1 et seq.

BOROUGH OF OAKLAND BERGEN COUNTY, NEW JERSEY ORDINANCE #23-Water Capital - 931

CAPITAL ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF OAKLAND, IN THE COUNTY OF BERGEN, NEW JERSEY AUTHORIZING THE MAKING OF VARIOUS PUBLIC IMPROVEMENTS AND ACQUISITIONS IN, BY AND FOR THE WATER UTILITY OF THE BOROUGH, APPROPRIATING THEREFOR THE SUM OF \$800,000 AND PROVIDING THAT SUCH SUM SO APPROPRIATED SHALL BE RAISED FROM THE WATER UTILITY CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND OF THE BOROUGH.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Oakland, in the County of Bergen, New Jersey, as follows:

Section 1. The Borough of Oakland, in the County of Bergen, New Jersey (the "Borough") is hereby authorized to make the following public improvements and acquisitions in, by and for the Water Utility of the Borough, including all work, materials and appurtenances necessary and suitable therefor:

(A) <u>General Water System Improvements and Acquisitions</u>

Various water system upgrades, acquisitions, and repairs including but not limited to:

Replacement of anode systems Acquisition of water meters Electrical upgrades Scheduled parts / system replacements

Estimated Cost Total: \$200,000

(B) Water Main Replacements

Replacement of various water mains

Estimated Cost Total: \$600,000

Section 2. The sum of \$800,000 is hereby appropriated to the payment of the cost of the improvements and acquisitions authorized and described in Section 1 hereof (hereinafter referred to as "purpose"). Said appropriation shall be raised from the Water Utility Capital Improvement Fund of the Borough. The sum of \$800,000 is hereby appropriated from the Water Utility Capital Improvement Fund of the Borough to the payment of the cost of said purpose.

Section 3. Said improvements are lawful capital improvements of the Borough having a period of usefulness of at least five (5) years. Said improvements shall be made as general improvements, no part of the cost of which shall be assessed against property specially benefited.

Section 4. The capital budget is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this capital ordinance to the extent of any inconsistency therewith and the resolutions promulgated by the Local Finance Board showing full detail of the amended capital budget and capital program as approved by the Director, Division of Local Government Services, is on file with the Borough Clerk and is available for public inspection.

Section 5. This ordinance shall take effect at the time and in the manner provided by law.

ORDINANCE NO. 23-CODE-932

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 9, SECTION 1.2 OF THE OAKLAND CODE RELATED TO VENOMOUS SNAKES

WHEREAS, the Borough of Oakland has regulated the parking of vehicles over three (3) tons; and

WHEREAS, the Borough wishes to amend the ordinance governing same to comply with the Endangered and Nongame Species Conservation Act ("ENSCA"), N.J.S.A. 23:2A-1 through 13;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, by the Mayor and Borough Council of Oakland as follows:

Section I. Chapter 9, Section 1.2(a)(8) of the Borough of Oakland Code entitled "Prohibited Activities" is hereby amended as follows:

9-1.2 Prohibited Activities.

- a. No person in a public park or in a public recreation area or Green Acres or open space area shall:
 - 8. Hunt, molest, harm, frighten, kill, trap, pursue, chase, tease, shoot or throw missiles at any animal, wildlife, reptile or bird or remove or have in possession the young of any wild animal, or the eggs or nest, or young of any reptile or bird.

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Section II. All other parts, portions and provisions of Chapter 9 of the Borough of Oakland Code be and the same are hereby ratified and confirmed, except where inconsistent with the terms hereof. In the event of any such inconsistency, the terms of this Ordinance shall be deemed to govern.

Section III. The terms of this Ordinance are hereby declared to be severable; should any part, portion or provision hereof be declared invalid or unconstitutional, said finding shall not affect any other part, portion or provision thereof.

Section IV. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final passage and publication according to law.
