AUTHORIZE GRANT REPURPOSE SUBMITTAL FOR FY 2021 BERGEN COUNTY OPEN SPACE TRUST FUND MUNICIPAL PARK INPROVEMENT FUND FOR TRUMAN FIELD REFURBISHMENTS

WHEREAS, the Bergen County Open Space, Recreation, Floodplain Protection, Farmland & Historic Preservation Trust Fund (the "County Trust Fund"), provides matching grants to municipal governments for assistance in the development or redevelopment of municipal recreation facilities; and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Oakland (the "Borough") had received a 2021 Trust Fund matching grant award of \$204,369, which was approved via County of Bergen Board of Chosen Freeholders Resolution No. 1094-21, dated December 15, 2021, for its "Truman Field Refurbishments" project (Project Contract No. 2100550); and

WHEREAS, Truman Field Refurbishments project was to include the construction of a New Surface, Leveling and Sprinkler System; and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Oakland desires to repurpose its 2021 Trust Fund Municipal Program grant award to include field lighting; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Borough Council has reviewed the County Trust Fund Program Statement, and the Trust Fund Municipal Program Park Improvement application and instructions and desires to make such a request for use of its grant and provide application information and furnish such documents as may be required; and

WHEREAS, as part of such request, the governing body received public comments on the proposed repurpose and use of its 2021 Trust Fund Municipal program grant award on February 22, 2023; and

WHEREAS, the County of Bergen shall determine whether the proposed request and use of the 2021 Trust Fund grant award are complete and in conformance with the scope and intent of the County Trust Fund; and,

WHEREAS, the Borough is willing to use the County Trust Fund grant in accordance with such rules, regulations and applicable statutes, and is willing to enter into an agreement with the County of Bergen for the approved project and ensure its completion on or about the project contract expiration date of December 15, 2023.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Mayor and Borough Council of the Borough of Oakland, in the County of Bergen, and State of New Jersey, as follows:

1. That it is hereby authorized to repurpose its 2021 Truman Field Refurbishments project application to the County; and,

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A:4-78b has authorized the Local Finance Board to adopt rules that permit municipalities in sound fiscal condition to assume the responsibility, normally granted to the Director of the Division of Local Government Services, of conducting the annual budget examination; and

WHEREAS, N.J.A.C. 5:30-7 was adopted by the Local Finance Board on February 11, 1997; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to N.J.A.C. 5:30-7.2 through 7.5, the Borough of Oakland, County of Bergen has been declared eligible to participate in the program by the Division of Local government Services, and the Chief Financial officer has determined that the local government meets the necessary conditions to participate in the program for the 2023 budget year.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Borough Council of the Borough of Oakland, in County of Bergen, and State of New Jersey, that in accordance with N.J.A.C. 5:30-7.6a & 7.6b and based upon the Chief Financial Officer's certification, the governing body has found the budget has met the following requirements:

- 1. That with reference to the following items, the amounts have been calculated pursuant to law and appropriated as such in the budget:
 - a) Payment of interest and debt redemption charges
 - b) Deferred charges and statutory expenditures
 - c) Cash deficit of preceding year
 - d) Reserve for uncollected taxes
 - e) Other reserves and non-disbursement items
 - f) Any inclusions of amounts required for school purposes.
- 2. That the provisions relating to limitation on increases of appropriations pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:4-45.2 and appropriations for exceptions to limits on appropriations found at N.J.S.A. 40A:4-45.3 et seq., are fully met (complies with CAP law).
- 3. That the budget is in such form, arrangement, and content as required by the Local Budget Law and N.J.A.C. 5:30-4 and 5:30-5.

- 4. That pursuant to the Local Budget Law:
 - a) All estimates of revenue are reasonable, accurate and correctly stated,
 - b) Items of appropriation are properly set forth
 - c) In itemization, form, arrangement and content, the budget will permit the exercise of the comptroller function within the municipality.
- 5. The budget and associated amendments have been introduced and publicly advertised in accordance with the relevant provisions of the Local Budget Law, except that failure to meet the deadlines of N.J.S.A. 40A:4-5 shall not prevent such certification.
- 6. That all other applicable statutory requirements have been fulfilled.
