CHICKEN ORDINANCE

NOTICE OF VIOLATION FOR MICROBLADING TO STAR LASH & BROW

Ms. Caperino stated that there would be an issuance for a notice of violation from the Construction Official to Star Lash and Brow for advertising microblading on a sign when they have not yet been approved for it by the Borough departments as yet. She said the Zoning and Construction officials' approval is required before advertising for that service, and additionally, she has not received paperwork in regard to requirements in the code that she had requested. She stated that they are currently closed, however, due to Covid-19. She believes that when they reopen they may begin making appointments for microblading in addition to the services that they are actually already approved for.


