#### HUB News

- o Englewood has agreed to host a Bergen County recycling center for plastic film and styrofoam and will be purchasing a Plastic Bailer (\$50k) and Cold Compression Condenser (\$100k) for Styrofoam. Buy in to dispose at their facility per municipality is \$2,000 one time fee. The Annual Clean communities grant that the Oakland has funding for already could potentially be used for the for the buy in to the Englewood Facility. Unspent BCUA Grant money will be used to help purchase bailer and cold compression condenser for styrofoam.

- Plastic Film Bins Carol Two clothing dumpster style bins will be purchased with the
  remaining funding from our BCUA grant. The location of the bins is in the process of changing
  away from using the Oakland Elks parking lot. We are now working with the First Aid Squad
  Chief Matt Goodrich (who also works for DPW and would be picking up the bins) and the town is
  in the process of getting the Mayor and Council to approve the location at the Dec 4th meeting.
- Anti Idle Ali This is complete and will be uploaded. We will not be doing this program again in the same way.
- Grants
  - Sustainable Jersey is coming out with more grants in 2020
  - O Roots for Rivers is ON! Carol intends to submit the grant for resolution at the 12/4 Council Meeting. This year's Roots for Rivers project will continue down Knuckles Path towards the Ramapo River. We'll be planting 252 plants this year (about half what we did last year). We also need to plan some maintenance on Black Friday (Nov for the netting, tubes and stakes 10:30AM.
